Biosecurity is an essential component of managing a farm.

All farmers must maintain the utmost levels of biosecurity in order to protect their animals and livelihood.

Buildings and the site in general need to be:

- Well maintained and
- → Clean, clear and access restricted

To keep track of the site,

there must be:

→ Accurate, well maintained records of people and vehicles entering and moving on and off farm



Vitally, the site should be secure to:

- → Prevent unwanted visitors like vermin and wild birds
- → Allow access to essential visitors only



Unwanted visitors, like rodents can: → Carry, introduce and

rapidly spread disease → Travel quickly from

premises to premises



Not keeping staff informed

→ Make biosecurity practises ineffective

→ Encourage disease spread on a single or multiple



should be: → Kept away from vermin

and wild birds, → Well wrapped, disinfected

and properly stored



ipment Misuse can spread disease.

Equipment should be: → Ideally, kept to singular

sheds and sites → Tracked and disinfected
